

GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The following scholarships are available for the students:

1. POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP TO SC / OBC STUDENTS

Scholarship offered by the Directorate of Social Welfare, Government of Goa to SC and OBC students, with family income ceiling as follows:

- a) SC – Rs. 2.50 lakh per annum
- b) OBC – Rs. 100,000/- per annum

2. THE GOA FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TOWARDS FEES FOR VARIOUS COURSES UNDER HIGHER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION SCHEME, also called “THE BURSARY SCHEME”

Students pursuing College (Higher and Professional) Education in the State of Goa including Post-Graduation shall be eligible to receive the benefits under this scheme, provided they meet the criteria laid down in the scheme.

The annual income of both the parents / guardian taken together should be less than rupees three lakhs.

The actual grant will be limited to the payment of fees and other charges given to the college / Institution.

Applications should be submitted to the Principal within fifteen days of the commencement of the academic year.

3. FEE WAIVER SCHEME FOR SC / ST STUDENTS PURSUING HIGHER EDUCATION

4. DAYANAND BANDODKAR SCHEME FOR ORPHAN STUDENTS PURSUING HIGHER EDUCATION

Under the above mentioned schemes at 3 and 4, fee waiver consists of tuition, library, laboratory and development fees, to be granted to students at the time of admission itself.

Proposals should reach the Directorate of Higher Education on or before 30th of September.

5. MERIT CUM MEANS SCHOLARSHIP TO THE STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES.

6. POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR ST STUDENTS FOR STUDIES IN INDIA in Govt. recognized Institutions.

The annual income of both the parents / guardian from all sources should not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/-

7. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ST STUDENTS UNDER “GAGAN BHARARI SHIKSHA YOJANA”

The annual family income of the students should be less than Rs. 3,00,000/-.

8. SCHEME FOR PROMOTION OF SCIENCE EDUCATION

Every student scoring 75% and above marks at Std XIIth examination and seeking admission for B.Sc. courses shall receive a scholarship of Rs. 2000 per month for maximum of thirty months and book/equipment grant of Rs. 5000/- per year till he completes his course.
